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2022 CT Broadleaf Research Trials


- 1) Fungicide Trial
 - Objective: Evaluate various registered and experimental fungicides and fungicide programs for control of late-season frogeye leafspot related to greenspot in cured leaf.
- 2) Lower Leaf Removal Trial
 - Objective: Evaluate the effect of lower leaf removal at layby or at topping, with or without fungicide application, on wrapper leaf production.

Research History

- Increase in demand for Connecticut Broadleaf.
- Dealers urged Kentucky producers to try and meet increased demand for natural leaf cigar wrappers.
- Research took place at the University of Kentucky Research and Education Center in Princeton, KY and private farm near Mayfield, KY
 - Fungicide Trials: 2019-2022
 - Evaluate fungicides on effectiveness against *late-season frogeye leafspot*.
 - Lower Leaf Removal Trials: 2021-2022
 - Evaluate effects of lower leaf removal on wrapper production.








Fungicide Trial

- 12 Fungicide treatments
- 1st application made 3 weeks after planting date
- Applications are made until time to harvest
- Fungicides were chosen based on effectiveness against frogeye leafspot
- All applications broadcasted with hollow cone nozzles
- All 4 rows sprayed; data came from center 2 rows
- 4 row plots 40' long; 40" row width with 32" plant spacing, gives plant population of 4,900 plants/acre
- Spray volume changed as tobacco increased in size
 - 15 gal/ac
 - 25 gal/ac
 - 40 gal/ac












2022 Fungicide Trial: Total Wrapper (lbs)



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*Total wrapper pounds were a sum of grades #3, #2, #1 yield/acre


2022 Fungicide Trial: Gross Revenue/Acre



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

2022 Lower Leaf Removal Trial: Wrapper Percentages






2022 Dealer Fungicide Total Yield/Acre (lbs/A) - Mayfield
















2022 Fungicide Trial: Total Yield/Acre - Springfield


2022 Fungicide Trial: Total Wrapper (lbs) - Springfield






2022 Fungicide Trial: Gross Revenue/Acre - Springfield



Summary of 2022 CT Broadleaf Research – Fungicide Trial (University Data)

 Dry conditions in 2022 limited treatment differences seen to fungicide treatments (low disease pressure), and limited plant response to lower leaf removal.

 No significant response to fungicides for wrapper leaf production at Mayfield or Springfield.

 Best treatments in 2022 trial (Springfield) were Manzate/Quadris/Revus program and Orondis Ultra

Summary of 2022 CT Broadleaf Research – Lower Leaf Removal Trial (University Data)

- Lower leaf removal resulted in average total yield loss of 71 lb/A (Mayfield) to 413 lb/A (Springfield)
- Unlike in 2021, there were no significant increases in wrapper pounds produced in lower leaf removal treatments.
 - Came closer to seeing a response in wrapper lbs at Mayfield when lower leaves were removed at topping.
- Lower leaf removal resulted in average \$181/A increase in gross revenue at Mayfield, but an average \$856/A decrease in gross revenue at Springfield.

Future Research

- Major problems with Frogeye Leafspot and greenspot have not occurred in 2021-2022. Would like to continue research in a year with more disease pressure.
- Plan to continue with a smaller fungicide trial in 2023, highlighting Miravis Top which should be registered for tobacco soon.
- Plan to continue with a smaller lower leaf removal trial.
